

Kawai Little Mozart's Program (2.5--5 years old)

Primer Class: 2.5—3.5 years old

The aim of the "Classroom Music for Little Mozarts" course is to provide a time to enjoy the fun of music for children aged under 4. Through singing, movement, listening and playing percussion, the course enables the young children to learn solid basic musical knowledge and to develop their listening skills and musical sense. In addition, the activities strengthen bonding between children and parents.

Course Content

- Basic Musical Concept and Listening ~ Basic musical concepts and symbols are introduced to students. Students also learn to identify if same and different sounds, rhythmic patterns, etc. Listening to music in a variety of styles helps develop their music and rhythmic sense.
- Playing percussion ~ Students have a chance to know the sound and color of various percussion instruments. It also trains their hand-eye coordination.
- Movement and Singing Activities ~ Students sing while using their bodies to express their ideas and feelings to a song. It develops motor coordination and concentration.

Course Structure

- One lesson per week, 45 minutes per lesson
- 15 lessons / 1st semester; 20 lessons / 2nd semester.
- Completion of 2 semesters with 85% attendance will receive a certificate and get promoted to "Music for Little Mozarts"
- One parent is required to attend classes with the student,

Course Materials

The course uses "Classroom Music for Little Mozart coloring sheets plus a starter kit including a music activity board and the three plush animal characters (Clara Schumann-Cat, Beethoven Bear and Mozart Mouse)

Advanced Class: 3.5—5 years old

The course aims at providing comprehensive musical training to students. Through movement, singing, ear training exercise and music appreciation, to develop general musicianship skills and keyboard skills.

Course Content:

- **Keyboard Skills and Musical Concepts**
The course centers around the adventures of Beethoven Bear and Mozarts Mouse as they learn about music. Students are introduced to new musical concepts and performances of pieces at the piano as they follow the story of Beethoven Bear Mozart's arts Mouse.
- **Movement and Singing Activities**
Students can experience music through singing, movement and response to rhythm patterns.
- **Ear Training**
The course includes well-planned listening activities to develop ear-training skills.
- **Music Appreciation**
Students will get to know 17 classical music composers and their masterpieces. Repeated exposure to such musical compositions will lead to the enjoyment and acceptance of music in a variety of styles. They will also learn about different instrumental families.

Course Structure:

- One lesson per week, 45 minutes per lesson
 - 15 lessons / 1st semester; 20 lessons / 2nd semester. A total of 2 semesters
- Completion of 1st and 2nd semesters with 85% attendance will receive a certificate of "Music for Little Mozart's Advanced Course" and get promoted to individual piano class.

Course Material:

The course uses a "Music for Little Mozart's" Music Lesson Book, a Music Workbook and a Starter Kit.
